About The Project



Co-designing a business capability tool for the Kangaroo Island community

The Kangaroo Island business community will benefit from a new online capability building tool to help reduce risks and limit the impact from disasters.

Delivered by corporate2community in collaboration with the Department for Innovation and Skills, the project is funded by SAFECOM.

Running from May to December 2022, the tool will support a new culture of micro learning for all business people with a focus on taking small steps to drive positive change.

Deliverables include:

- engage with local steering committee to identify theme and integrate current initiatives from April to May
- workshops across the Island in June
- online tool content development July-September, filming local business people to present learning modules
- launch in late 2022 with tool available FREE to local Kangaroo Island businesses
- draft white paper to publish findings by December 2022
