Projects helping build South Australia's resilience to natural disasters were celebrated at the 2023 Resilient Australia South Australian Award ceremony, held at Government House this evening.

Her Excellency and Mr Bunten heard about the outstanding contributions of South Australian individuals, communities, NGOs, government agencies, and many other organisations in making our state more resilient to disasters.

This year's winners include a free digital resource for Kangaroo Island business owners designed to mitigate impacts of natural disaster, and a project developed in response to the Cudlee Creek bushfire to restore areas that were destroyed by the blaze.

The six state winners of the five categories - Community, Government, Local Government, Business, and Photography - will be entered into the National Resilient Australia Awards, to be announced later this year.
