Retail, professional services and education

Agribusiness and aqua business

Forestry; hobby farmers; market gardeners, fruit and vegetable farmers; sheep, beef and dairy farmers; aquaculture and fishing; food processing and packaging; wholesale and retail; machinery suppliers and repairers; farm hands; cropping; transport.



Tourism

Accommodation; transportation; tour guides and activities; tourist attractions; cultural tourism; souvenir shops; wineries, breweries and distilleries; destination restaurants; wedding, retreat and conference facilities; agritourism; car hire.



Health care and community services
